Our Story

The Sun Valley Museum of Art was founded in 1971 on the belief that a thriving engaged community demands arts and culture to be viable and sustainable. As the oldest arts organization in the Wood River Valley and one of only five institutions in Idaho accredited by the American Alliance of Museums, SVMoA serves as a community anchor in the Wood River Valley and a cultural keystone in the state of Idaho, bringing residents and visitors together for shared arts experiences. The Museum offers world-class year-round programming in visual arts, music, film, and the humanities.

The Sun Valley Museum of Art has grown from a handful of artists presenting classes and events to a robust professional arts organization that serves tens of thousands of patrons annually. The original campus of the Sun Valley Center for the Arts and Humanities was founded by Glenn Janss, and was established on land deeded by Bill Janss, her husband and owner of Sun Valley Company (1964–1977), along Trail Creek. SVMoA flourished at this location as a facility for high-level fine arts residencies, hosting artists and faculty that have since achieved celebrated careers.

Today, the Sun Valley Museum of Art is a thought leader in the Intermountain West. The Museum's visual art, film and performance programming is diverse, inclusive and inspiring. Uniquely situated in an International Dark Sky Reserve in pristine Idaho wilderness with a diverse mountain community, SVMoA has hosted scores of award-winning artists, innovative thinkers and distinguished scholars from around the world to explore, inspire and collaborate with the community at the Museum, on the stage and in the classroom.
